Hello Everyone,

Online registration for the Hollandia Outdoor 2017 season will be **open online beginning Monday February 20th**. We will be holding an **In-Person Registration on Wednesday March 1st**.

Online Registration: February 20th – March 4th, 2017. Fees to be paid by credit card.

In-Person Registration: Wednesday March 1st, 2017 from 6:00-8:30 at Lawson Civic Center Library on Primrose Drive. Fees to be paid by cash, cheque or credit card.

2017 Outdoor Fees for Age Groups

Under 8	Born 2009/2010	Full Registration Fees: \$80 (Does not include individual team fees, uniform deposit and volunteer deposit)** Instalment Payments: \$40 due at time of registration, \$40 due by March 31st
Under 10	Born 2007/2008	Full Registration Fees: \$145 (Does not include individual team fees, uniform deposit and volunteer deposit)** Instalment Payments: \$72.50 due at time of registration, \$72.50 due by March 31st
Under 12	Born 2005/2006	Full Registration Fees: \$270 and includes skill sessions* (Does not include individual team fees, uniform deposit and volunteer deposit)** Instalment Payments: \$135 due at time of registration, \$135 due by March 31st
Under 14	Born 2003/2004	Full Registration Fees: \$270 and includes skill sessions* (Does not include individual team fees, uniform deposit and volunteer deposit)** Instalment Payments: \$135 due at time of registration, \$135 due by March 31st
Under 16	Born 2001/2002	Full Registration Fees: \$270 and includes skill sessions* (Does not include individual team fees, uniform deposit and volunteer deposit)** Instalment Payments: \$135 due at time of registration, \$135 due by March 31st
Under 20	Born 97, 98, 99, 00	Full Registration Fees: \$215 (Does not include individual team fees, uniform deposit and volunteer deposit)** Instalment Payments: \$107.50 due at time of registration, \$107.50 due by March 31st

***Skill Sessions:** To ensure that all Hollandia players, regardless of division, have equal access to highly qualified coaches, Hollandia provides Skill Sessions run by paid coaches for every player in the club. To keep the training costs low, the costs are averaged over all registered players and built into registration fees. Players cannot opt out of paying this training fee, and it is an integral part of Hollandia's developmental policy.

Note: U20s are exempt from skill sessions.

****Individual Team Fees:** Includes Turf Fees (where applicable) and fees for any additional costs agreed upon by the team, such as coach's gifts, tournament fees, and team functions. The team fees usually average between \$150 - \$300 in the outdoor season depending on your child's age and the division in which they play.

****Team Uniform Deposit:** Collected by your team manager. A cheque in the amount of \$50 must be postdated for July 31, 2017 and will ONLY be cashed if your child's uniform is not returned; otherwise, it will be disposed of.

****Volunteer Deposit:** Collected by your team manager. A cheque in the amount of \$100 must be postdated for July 31, 2017 and will only be cashed if you do not volunteer for the required 3 hours.

Late Registration Fee: \$25 (applied after March 4th, 2017)

Late Registration fees will be applied beginning March 4th, 2017 at 11:55PM. All late Registration fees must be paid online by credit card and in full OR you must contact the Registrar, Liz Petersen registrar@hollandiasoccer.com, to make payment/registration arrangements.

After Registration

Please note that for outdoor 2017, there will be a premier division for regular league play in divisions U12-U20. This is a difference from previous years. For more information on the age groups and anticipated game nights please see Saskatoon Youth Soccer:

Once our registration period is closed, you will receive an e-mail invitation to an evaluation session. We will also post this schedule on our website once it is available. The purpose of the evaluation sessions is twofold:

- To ensure players are placed on teams playing at a similar developmental and competitive level; and
- Where there will be more than one team in an age group/division to attempt to balance the teams.

If your child does not wish to take part in the evaluation session, please indicate this and they will automatically be placed on a division 3 team. To learn more about Hollandia's evaluation or team placement policies, please look at these policies on our website:
